FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Why should I choose Legacy Horse Camp for my child?

Legacy Hunters & Jumpers is a USHJA (US Hunter Jumper Association) Certified Riding Academy with credentialed instructors on well-trained horses and ponies. Our camp sessions are designed for passionate young equestrians aspiring to develop a solid foundation in riding and horsemanship skills.

Where is Legacy located?

Legacy's beautiful 5-acre farm is in the Bear Creek area of Woodinville, adjacent to the Tolt Pipeline Trail. Address: 19802 NE 148th St. Woodinville, WA 98077.

What will my child learn?

Campers will receive one hunt seat (English) riding lesson each day and learn basic skills such as handling, leading, grooming, tacking before and after their lesson. The remainder of our time is dedicated to learning horsemanship through games and interactive experiences. This includes barn safety, general horse care and health, tack and equipment stewardship, and equestrian terminology.

What are the requirements?

- Legacy accepts campers between the ages of 7 and 11 years (second through fifth grades).
- Paddock boots with a heel and an ASTM/SEI certified English riding helmet are required. Local tack stores can assist with these purchases and offer discount coupons for beginning riders.
- A pre-camp evaluation lesson is required prior to the camp session and is included in camp tuition fees.

Why the pre-camp evaluation lesson?

The pre-camp lesson allows our instructors to assess your child's abilities and prior knowledge to tailor the camp experience to your child's riding level. This also offers your child an opportunity to become familiar with our facility, staff, and horses, to prepare them for a great time at camp.

(Lessons in addition to the evaluation lesson may be taken. Cost: \$100/lesson)

What are camp session days and times?

Tuesday through Friday. 9:30 AM – 3:00 PM.

What is the cost?

Tuition is \$960 per session. This includes one pre-camp assessment lesson. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required to process enrollment prior to May 31st. The balance of \$860 is due on May 31st. Full payment is due if enrolling after May 31st.

How do I go about enrolling my child in the Legacy camp program?

Please email the camp interest application form listing your preferred session dates, to office@legacyhuntersjumpers.com. A staff member will confirm camp session availability and provide registration forms. Completed registration with payment information will secure the spot for your child.

Is it possible for my child to ride year-round?

Our USHJA Certified Riding Academy operates year-round. Cost: \$100/lesson, sold in monthly packages. Minimum requirement is 2 lessons per week. Legacy also offers riding lessons for teens and adults.

Can my child participate in horse shows?

Legacy hosts on-site horse shows for students of all levels. Classes range from beginner walk-trot to advanced courses over jumps. A qualified judge, announcer and show staff create an authentic horse show experience.

Who is Legacy?

Founded in 1984 by third-generation equestrian Shelly Kerron, Legacy is a premier hunter jumper training facility that prepares horses and riders for the competitive show circuit. As owner and head trainer, Shelly oversees all aspects of Legacy's operation and riding programs. Under her guidance, the experienced staff and instructors at Legacy provide a positive and safe atmosphere where every rider can excel to their greatest potential.

Is it possible for my child to pursue horse ownership and competitive riding at Legacy?

If you are considering horse ownership, we encourage a consultation with Shelly to evaluate lease and ownership options against the goals of the rider to determine how to best meet your needs.
